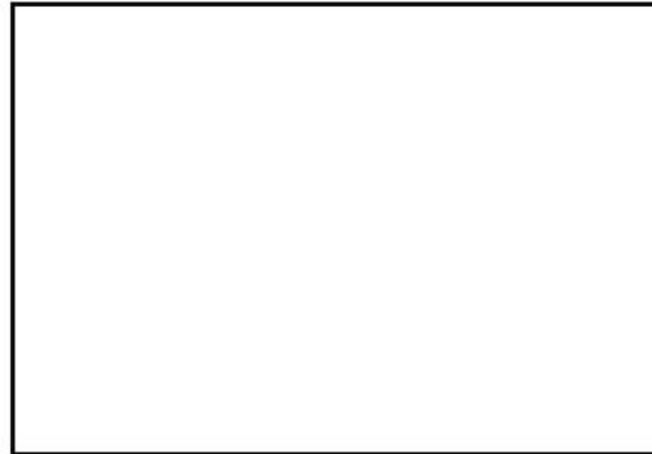

Camels live in the desert.

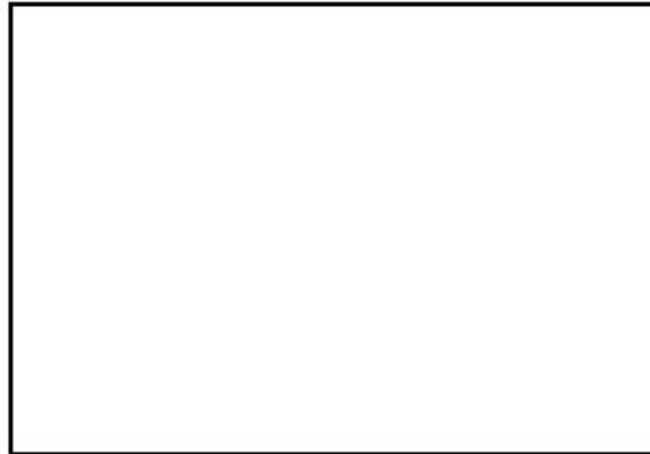

The gorilla is a primate.

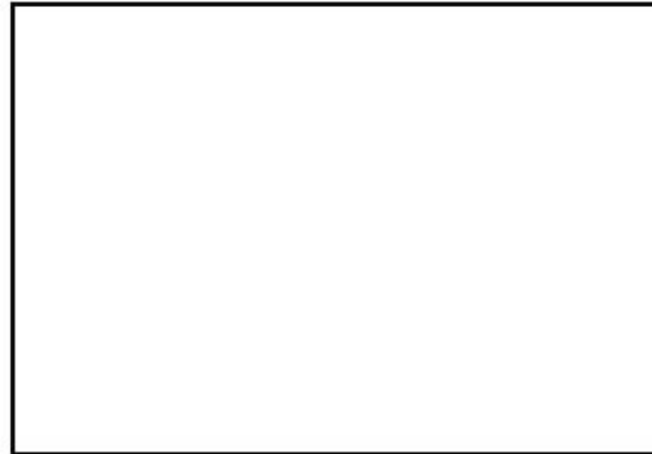

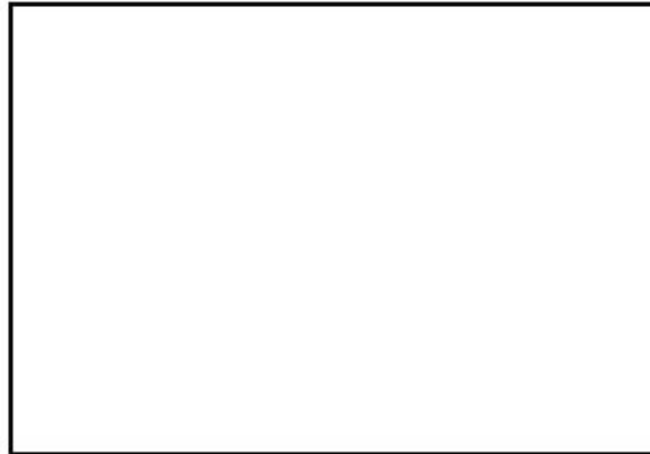
The hippo likes to swim.

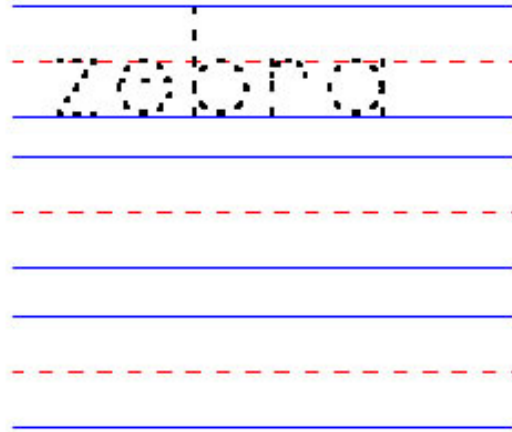

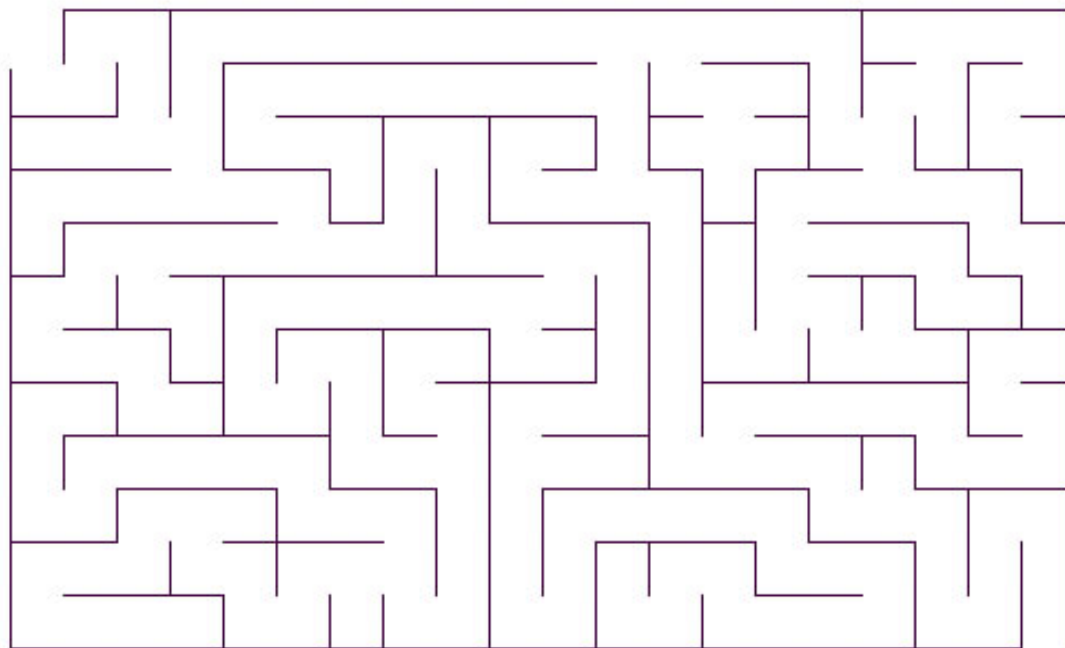

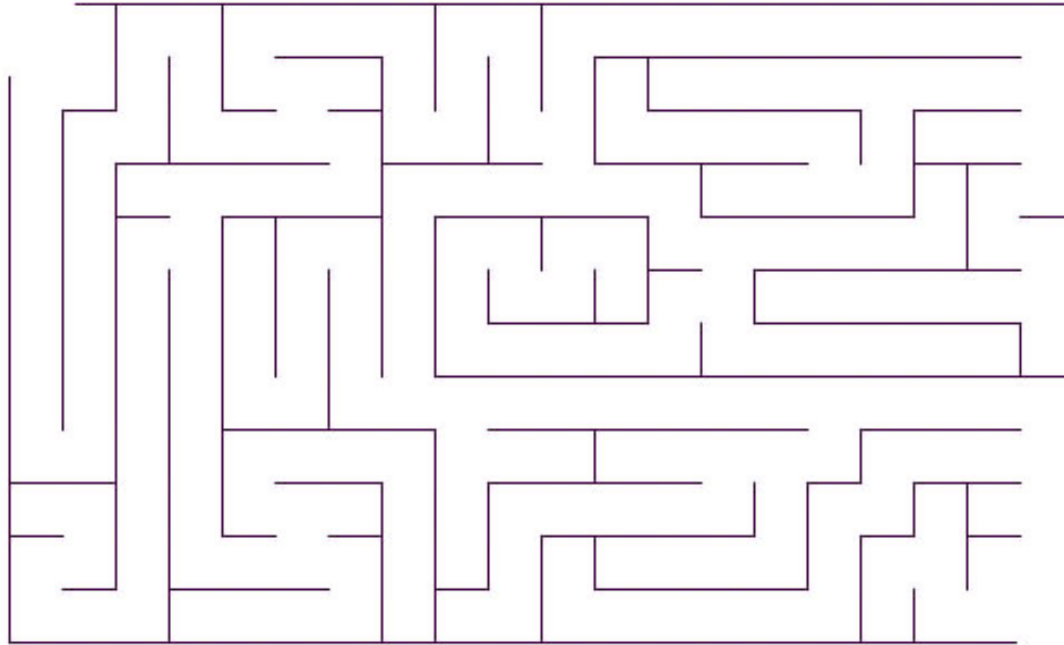
Elephants like to drink water. They use their trunks like a straw. Can you help this elephant to his water?

his way to his food?

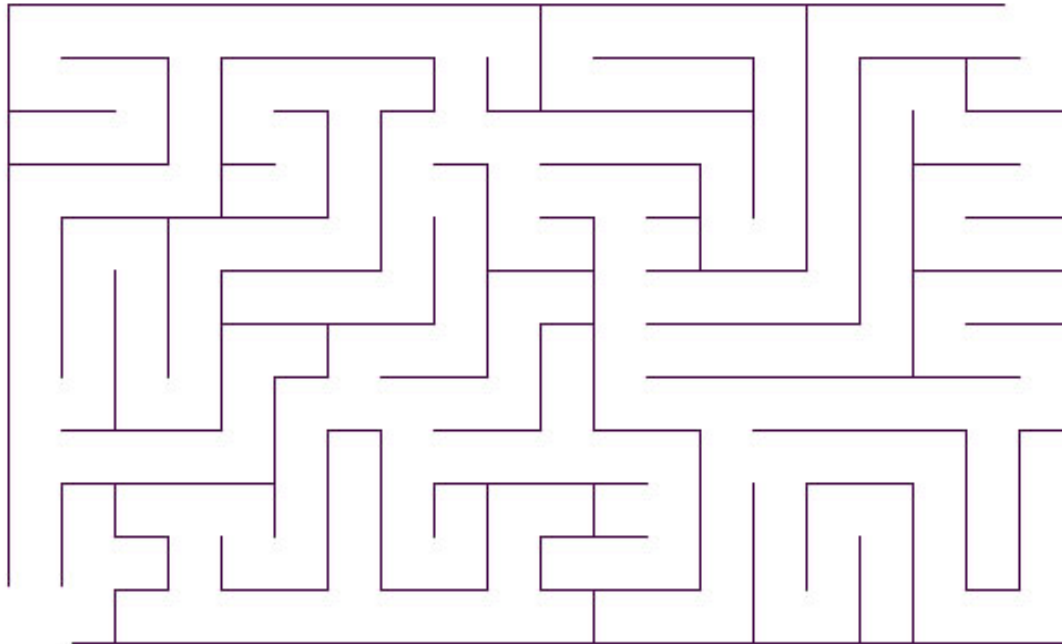


Bamboo
